# Home Cooking

## Morning Pie

Prep Time: 10 minutes

Cook Time: 55 minutes

### Ingredients

- 1 lb pork sausage with sage, cooked & crumbled
- 1 cup shredded Swiss cheese
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
- 2 (9 inch) unbaked pastry shells
- 6 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 cup milk
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1/3 cup chopped sweet red pepper
- 1/3 cup chopped green pepper

### Directions:

In a bowl, combine sausage and cheese. Place half of mixture in each pastry shell. Combine eggs, milk, onion and peppers. Pour half over sausage in each shell. Bake at 350 degrees F for 55-60 minutes or until a knife inserted near the center comes out clean. Let stand 5 minutes before cutting.

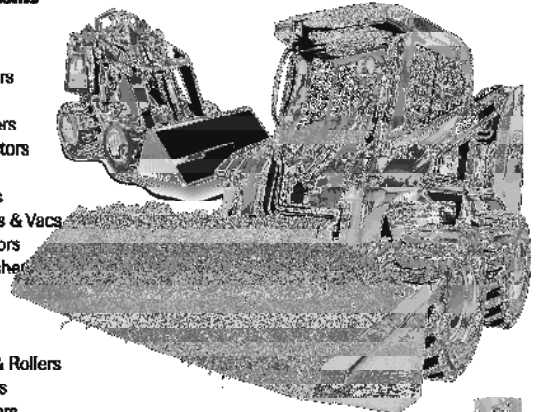

From the  
“Green  
Thumb”  
Guy.....

Happy New Year to all my wonderful neighbors! As I reflect on the past year I sure remember the summer heat and dryness, and now that 2012 is here I hope to put those memories long behind me and look forward to better gardening days ahead. Even though we're in the midst of winter, there are some chores to be tended to in our yards. It has been fairly dry still so grab the hose and water your landscape plants, especially those that have been planted in the last year. My lawn seems to be moist so I'm not in a big hurry to run the sprinkler but a few more warm days and I may have to get a little H<sub>2</sub>O on the grass. If some weeds are popping up, find a relatively warm day or two and treat them with an appropriate weed killer. Getting your power equipment to the shop for its annual maintenance is much easier during the slow months of winter. Now is still the perfect time to prune deciduous trees (those are the ones that have dropped their leaves) as well as Live Oaks and fruit trees. Make sure not to prune any trees or shrubs that will be blooming in the springtime such as Forsythia, Indian Hawthorne, or Redbuds for instance. Pruning them now will remove their flower buds and you will lose the beauty of their blooms. The best time for pruning those plants is immediately after they finish flowering. While we're on the subject, please don't whack the Crepe Myrtles back to mere stubs of their former selves. It creates a weak branching structure, it is stressful on the trees, and it's just a lot of unnecessary work on your part. As far as the veggie garden goes, this is a great time to add some organic matter and a little dab of slow release fertilizer and work 'em both into the soil. Believe it or not the next few weeks will be the time to plant many types of cool-season vegetable seeds such as Spinach, Lettuce, or English Peas as well as others, and you'll already find Onions at the garden centers or feed stores. Always look for a certified nursery professional or horticulturist to help you out with your questions and I've also found that a neighbor who has a few years of gardening under his or her belt can provide a bounty of information! May your yard and garden give you much pleasure and joy and let's all have the best year ever! -Steve

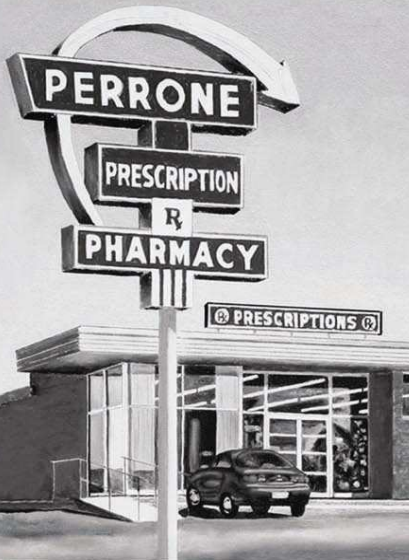

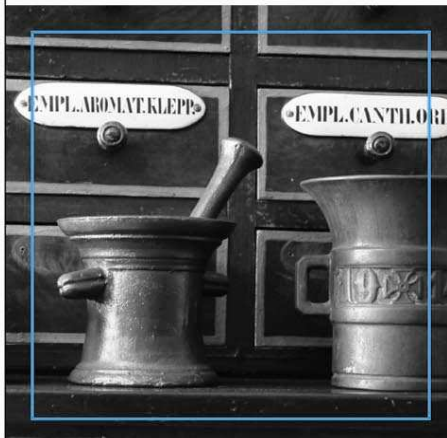
